



Mailbox Damage

The City of Meadville repairs or replaces only mailboxes and/or posts that are actually struck by the plow blade. Usually a paint mark or truck tires supply evidence of a mailbox strike. The City of Meadville does not repair or replace mailboxes and/or posts that fall from the force of plowed snow. Mailboxes and supporting post must be installed to withstand the rigors of snow removal, including the force of snow pushed from the street onto the roadside.
