Permits for work in the City right-of-way

- A. Permit requirements (NOTE: "Within city streets" means any area within the right of way as designated in the records of the city of a street or roadway officially accepted as a city street, open to and used for public travel within the City of Meadville.
- Street occupancy permit required for:
 1. Constructing, cutting, modifying, altering, repairing or otherwise affecting any curb marking the boundary of any paved street or the cartway of any unpaved street.
 2. Connecting a driveway to a city street or reconstructing the apron.
 3. Opening, excavating or digging within city streets.
 4. Constructing or installing any gas pipe, water pipe, electric conduit, sewer pipe or other type of piping or facilities within city streets.
 5. Installation or erection of any pole or erected structure for telephone, cable, electric or any other service within city streets.
 6. Placing, constructing or installing any device or thing which obstructs public travel or public use within city streets.
 - Sidewalk permit required for constructing, repairing or reconstructing any sidewalk within the public right-of-way.
- B. Process:
- (a) Obtain a permit from the Permit Clerk in the Management & Development Office on the second floor of the City Building, 984 Water St. Call 814.333.3351 or e-mail cityzoning@cityofmeadville.org for more information or to order a permit.
 - (b) Call Pennsylvania One-Call at (800) 248-1786 to locate underground utilities prior to digging
 - (c) Call 814.333.3324 for inspections at the following times:
 - (1) when forms are assembled
 - (2) when concrete pour for sidewalks is completed
- C. Specifications for the particular job will be provided with the permit.
